

Best VPNs for Bravo: Watch From Anywhere in 2022

META DESCRIPTION

We tested dozens of VPNs to find the best ones for Bravo. See which VPNs can unblock Bravo and provide the best speeds for streaming.

INTRODUCTION

You'd like to stream video from Bravo, and you're thinking about adding a Virtual Private Network (VPN) to your internet ecosystem. Good choice. A VPN will increase your privacy by concealing your Internet Protocol (IP) address, and your security by encrypting your data, often to a military specification.

We tested the leaders, followers and free VPNs, and found that some could not unlock Bravo, while others were too slow for 4K/HD streaming. We settled on five major VPNs, each capable of unlocking Bravo and fast enough for streaming video without latency.

All of the five services worked for streaming Bravo, but in the end we recommend NordVPN for its performance and capabilities. We also liked its generous [X]-day money-back guarantee. We recommend you read our complete review, which includes noteworthy features for each of the five services that may influence your own choice.

Like your physical address, your IP address uniquely identifies you and your location. Let's say you live in Detroit and have traveled to Kansas City. When you log in from your hotel, you will immediately begin seeing ads for local Kansas City businesses. How does it know that? That's your IP address in action. So, is that Big Brother? Or a valuable consumer service? It depends, but most people prefer keeping their surfing and buying habits to themselves.

VPNs also encrypt data to an extremely high standard, often to a military specification. Encryption scrambles your data so that it can only be unscrambled by its intended recipient. Anyone who could successfully penetrate your private

browsing would simply not be able to read what you sent. That could be quite useful if you wanted to make a stock trade while sitting at the airport.

NordVPN

- More than 5,000 servers in 62 countries.

- Reliably fast under stress testing. Fastest of the group in a recent test by AV-TEST, an independent testing organization.
- \$3.71 per month for a 2-year plan is not the lowest, but still affordable.
- Devices: 6.
- Dedicated IP option available.

ExpressVPN

- More than 3,000 servers in more than 90 countries.
- Jurisdiction: British Virgin Islands (no logging).
- An industry leader with many fans.
- Devices: 5.
- Highest price of the group, \$6.67 per month for 15 months, then \$8.95 thereafter on a 1-year plan.

- Option to pay in Bitcoin adds another layer of privacy.

SurfShark

- More than 3,000 servers in 65 countries.
- Jurisdiction: British Virgin Islands (no logging).
- Chrome and Firefox extensions passed a recent audit by Cure 53, a German security firm.
- Camouflage mode hides your VPN usage from your ISP.
- Devices. By far the most liberal policy: unlimited!
- \$2.49 per month for a 2-year plan, the second lowest.

CyberGhost

- More than 7,000 servers in more than 90 countries.
- Jurisdiction: Romania (no logging).
- Split-tunneling on Windows servers.
- Connect up to 5 devices.
- Lowest price of the group, just \$2.25 per month with a 3-year contract.
\$3.49 per month for 2 years.
- Dedicates servers to specific tasks to optimize performance: NoSpy, torrenting, streaming video.

Private Internet Access

- More than 25,000 servers in 77 countries.
- A 2-year plan is just \$2.69 per month, among the lowest.
- Devices: 10, second most generous in the group.
- Multiple protocol support.
- Unlimited bandwidth.
- 30 day money back guarantee.

WHY YOU NEED A VPN

Content providers like Bravo (or Netflix, Prime, Disney, HBO Go, etc.) commonly use location (“geoblocking”) to control access to their systems. For example, Bravo blocks European access to its US content (“library”), and vice versa. With a VPN, the content provider cannot view your IP address and therefore can’t use your location to filter you out. You may think, why would I want to do that, anyway? Well, let’s say you are an American sitting somewhere in the US, and you want to watch the Olympics commercial-free and in real time. If you could get to the BBC you could do that, but sitting in the US, NBC broadcasts the Olympics, sometimes tape delayed and with commercials. With a VPN you could unlock BBCi, and voila! Show me the badminton, please.

In a more sinister way, some countries, especially China, block access to foreign websites, not for commercial purposes, but political. The wise Chinese leadership thinks it knows better than its citizens what kind of information they need to be well-informed, they use the ubiquitous IP address to control it. So a VPN, which conceals the IP address, is what you need to circumvent such controls. And it works most of the time. By the way, this is a time when you might want to check how many servers a VPN provider has in the country you plan to visit. And if you’re going to China, be sure to install your VPN before leaving the US. You will not be able to access your provider or download needed software from there.

While you could use any of our five “finalists” to stream Bravo, we recommend NordVPN. It has 5,200 servers located in 62 countries and is known for its harmonious blend of speed, security and privacy. NordVPN did run into a spot of trouble when it was revealed that a server it leases in Finland had been hacked. Worse, the hack occurred in 2018 but not revealed until 2019, creating something of a credibility gap. If there was a silver lining, it’s that it showed that no-ogging worked as intended. The hackers were unable to find any user information whatsoever. NordVPN allows up to six devices at a best price of \$3.71 for a 2-year plan.

Can I use a free VPN to watch **Bravo?**

Free is always tempting, especially when its advocates have the best of intentions. However, they guarantee neither of the two things you look for in a VPN, privacy and security, not to mention the other features or support for-profit services offer. And at today's prices, as low as \$2.25 per month, it's simply not worth the risk or inconvenience.

A better solution is one of the many solid providers, especially the five in our testing, who offer reliable performance, features and support, at a low price. Choose one like NordVPN, which offers a 30-day guarantee. That's plenty of time to give it a thorough test, and if you're unhappy, they'll refund your money.

Which VPN is the fastest?

In a recent study by AV-TEST, an independent testing organization, NordVPN was crowned the fastest. That matches our own results, as well.

How can I get a **British IP address?**

Let's say you are in the US but want to access BBCi. The BBC would filter out a US IP address, so you want to appear as if you are located in the UK. VPN to the rescue. The VPN conceals your real IP address, but at the other end your service provider can assign it one of thousands of IP addresses each company maintains for exactly this purpose.

Get the Best VPN for Bravo Today

Content providers like Bravo routinely use location, revealed by your IP address, to control access to their programming. For example, Bravo blocks European access to its US content ("library"), and vice versa. With a VPN, the content provider can't do that. You may think, why would I care? Well, let's say you are an American sitting somewhere in the US, and you want to watch the Olympics commercial-free and in real time. You'll need to use the BBC instead of the American NBC. A VPN will help you unlock BBCi, the BBC's digital service, and voila! Show me the badminton, please.

We looked at five VPN service providers and found them were sufficient for achieving our goal of connecting to Bravo. That said, they're not equals in their speed or security, or in other features. For example, SurfShark offers configurable

multi-hop connections to optimize performance, and CyberGhost offers dedicated servers for streaming and torrenting, while Express VPN lets you pay in Bitcoin. Overall, we believe that NordVPN offers the best combination of speed (the fastest we tested, confirmed by a third party), security, features and price, just \$3.71 per month.
